6142. Parking at the village green

Cllrs agreed to respond to the enquiry confirming that parking on the hardstanding by the village green when visiting family in Broadwoodwidge is acceptable. However, there is no permission for residents to park regularly. The Clerk would also request that anyone parking there is mindful of busier times such as when a Church service or local event is taking place.

6143. Speeding in rural areas
