**6261. Planning**

**4.1 1/0423/2026/FUL** - Agricultural storage building, Land At Grid Reference 241477 90327, Broadwoodwidge – councillors agreed to object to the application on the grounds of overdevelopment, scale and sustainability of the land. The full comment can be viewed on the TDC planning portal. Motion proposed by Cllr Gibson, seconded by Cllr Fry and agreed by all.

**4.2 1/0396/2026/LBC & 1/0376/2026/FUL** - Erection of solar panels to roof, Holm Barn, Broadwoodwidge – councillors agreed to object to the applications on the grounds of effect on listed buildings. The full comment can be viewed on the TDC planning portal. Motion proposed by Cllr Worden, seconded by Cllr Gibson and agreed by all.

**4.3 1/0374/2026/AGMB** - Prior notification for the change of use of agricultural building to 4no. dwellinghouses and associated building operations under Class Q. - Agricultural Building At Grid Reference 240624 89577, Broadwoodwidge – councillors agreed to object to the application on the grounds of overdevelopment, out of keeping with local area, layout and site design and contrary to the local plan. The full comment can be viewed on the TDC planning portal. Motion proposed by Cllr Gibson, seconded by Cllr Hosken and agreed by all.

**4.4 1/0375/2026/AGMB** - Barn At Grid Reference 240355 089473, Broadwoodwidge – councillors agreed not to comment.

**6262. Grants**

Cllr Gibson declared an interest in the item and abstained from discussions and voting. Following agreement in principle made at the meeting of May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026, councillors approved a grant of £2000 towards grass cutting in the churchyard for 25/26. The motion was proposed by Cllr Beazley, seconded by Cllr Fry and agreed by all.
